



Keeping the above quote in mind, Sairam Vidyalaya started in 2800 Sq.ft. with 144 students in the year 2010. Our "Sairam Vidyalaya Sr. Sec. Now we are happy to share with you that our school campus boasts a vast area of 60,000 square feet with a build-up area of 42,145 square feet with 1500 students. This expansive space includes a spacious playground that caters to a wide range of sports activities, including archery, softball, throwball and more.

Ensuring the safety and security of our students is of paramount importance to us, to this end, we have installed a comprehensive surveillance system comprising 160 cameras, covering all classrooms and the entire school campus.

Incorporating technology into education is another area where we excel. We are proud to have 50 smart classrooms with high speed internet which enhance the teaching and learning experience for both students and teachers alike. These smart boards facilitate interactive and engaging lessons, making education more dynamic.

To support various academic pursuits, we have 100 well spacious air conditioned classrooms, a spacious student friendly library housing nearly 10,000 books encompassing fiction, novels and reference materials for all subjects.

Additionally, we have dedicated laboratories for physics, chemistry, biology, robotics and mathematics, providing hands-on learning experiences that foster curiosity and innovation.

The health and wellbeing of our students are also of utmost importance. We provide clean and safe drinking water through our own RO Plant, ensuring that our students have access to high quality water throughout the day. Moreover, to address any power supply issues, we have a continuous electricity supply system, including a genset.

In our School, we are dedicated to providing our children with a nurturing and enriching educational environment that supports their holistic development. We take pride in our state of the art facilities, and we are committed to maintaining high standards of education and safety.

We are an ISO certified Institution from 2015 and affiliated to CBSE.


FACILITIES


